

Hospital Beds (HP.1) – End 2010

At end 2010 there were eight hospital establishments in Malta and Gozo. Five were state hospitals while three were for profit private hospitals. The State hospitals were: Mater Dei Hospital (HP.1.1), Gozo General Hospital (HP.1.1), Mount Carmel Hospital (HP.1.2), Sir Paul Boffa Hospital (HP.1.3) and Rehabilitation/Karen Grech Hospital (HP.1.3). The private hospitals were St. James (Capua) hospital (HP.1.1), St. James Hospital (Zabbar) (HP.1.1) and St. Philip hospital (HP.1.1). Five of the hospital establishments were general hospitals (HP.1.1).
