

### National Hospital beds - Malta and Gozo – End 2007

There were ten hospitals in Malta and Gozo at end 2007. Seven were State hospitals and three were privately owned. The State hospitals were: Mater Dei Hospital, Gozo General Hospital, St. Vincent de Paule Residence, Mount Carmel Hospital, Sir Paul Boffa Hospital, Zammit Clapp Hospital and Karen Grech Rehabilitation Centre. The “private” hospitals were St. Philip Hospital, St. James (Capua) Hospital and St. James Hospital, Zabbar.
