

**National Hospital beds - Malta and Gozo – October 2006**

In Malta and Gozo there are nine hospitals in all. Six are State hospitals and three are privately owned. The State hospitals are: St. Luke’s Hospital, Gozo General Hospital, St. Vincent de Paule Residence, Mount Carmel Hospital, Sir Paul Boffa Hospital and Zammit Clapp Hospital. The “private” hospitals are St. Philip Hospital, St. James (Capua) Hospital and St. James Hospital, Zabbar.

The available beds distribution in hospitals in Malta and Gozo as in October 2006, is shown in the following table:
