

### Hospital Beds (HP.1) – End 2009

At end 2009 there were nine hospital establishments in Malta and Gozo. Zammit Clapp Hospital and Karen Grech Rehabilitation Hospital were under the same management. Available beds in the different institutions were as follows:

The total numbers of hospital beds at end 2009 show a substantial reduction from previous years. This was mainly due to the fact that St. Vincent de Paule Residence, which up to 2008 was considered as a geriatric hospital, was licensed as a residential and nursing care institution (HP.2) during 2009.
