NOTICE ISSUED BY THE ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH DIRECTORATE

The Environmental Health Directorate within the Superintendence of Public Health wishes to notify that following repeated sampling of seawater carried out on a daily basis during the last days the bathing sites at St. Paul's Bay – in the vicinity of Wharf in front of Fekruna Pumping Station (Site Code C 18) and Xlendi Bay (Site Codes D04, D05, D06 and D07) are once again fit for bathing and thus the health warning is hereby being lifted.

However, the public is informed that bathing is still not recommended at St. George's Bay, St. Julian's until further notice.

Health warning signs indicating the exact zones involved have been fixed in the areas.
