In accordance with the Food Safety Act and Regulation (EC) No. 178 of 2002 of the European Parliament and of the Council, the Environmental Health Directorate within the Superintendence of Public Health wishes to inform the public that following analysis carried out, the following product must not be consumed due to the possible presence of salmonella enteritidis which is not in conformance with EU Regulation 2073 of 2005.
