Structure, Functions and Responsibilities

The Council for Professionals Complementary to Medicine, Malta (CPCM) regulates the professions that are complementary to medicine in Malta, which list can be accessed through <https://deputyprimeminister.gov.mt/en/regcounc/cpcm/Pages/cpcm.aspx>. Its function is defined in the Health Care Professions Act 2003.

A primary function of the CPCM is to regulate the addition to and exit from a register of one of the health care professionals mentioned earlier in the link. The Council is responsible for the justification of educational standards and resume of practice done for the specified profession as per benchmarks set. Each profession under the CPCM published the Code of Practice and execute towards the fulfilment of excellence in the delivery of professional care and safeguarding of the patients by boosting continuing professional development amongst its registrants.
