Clarifications No. 2

Reference is made to the Request for participation in caption.

Hereunder please find a clarification which is construed to form an integral part of the RfP procurement document.

Clarification 2 : With reference to RFP 020-6127/20 CPSU 4239/20, Clause re Storage in Page 30 of Section 3 - Specification, the tender states: "Without prejudice, the Contracting Authority reserves the right to lease Smart Cabinets from the awarded Contractor. It is therefore required that a cost of leasing such Smart Cabinets be furnished."

Could you clarify what this means exactly, as it does not make sense in this context.

We would have expected that the successful tenderer would either:

a. Provide his own Smart Cabinets to be used for the duration of the tender.

OR

b. Be expected to utilise Smart Cabinets that are provided by the Contracting Authority.

Why would the successful tenderer be expected to lease Smart Cabinets to the Contracting Authority here?

Answer 2 : Basically, and because we still do not have our smart cabinets in place, there are 2 options.

The supplier would either supply his own cabinets, and thus CPSU would need to know the cost for this. Supplier must quote for the items and the cost of leasing the smart cabinets separately

OR

The supplier would make use of our own cabinets; therefore, we would need to know the cost of the items without cabinets.

All other tender documents, conditions and requirements, which are not superseded by this Clarification, remain in place.
