GS1 Malta has recently signed an agreement with Central Procurement Supplies Unit Malta.

The main aim of this agreement is to help CPSU implement globally unique identifiers for medicines and medical devices, followed by locations and assets. CPSU sees use of GS1 standards as a mechanism to drive efficiency and accuracy through their warehousing and distribution processes.

GS1 Malta is the Maltese member of the GS1, a not-for-profit global standards development organisation. The development and implementation of GS1 standards is led by the industry experts who use them.
