ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH DIRECTORATE NOTICE

In accordance with the Food Safety Act and Regulation (EC) No. 178 of 2002 of the European Parliament and of the Council, the Environmental Health Directorate within the Superintendence of Public Health wishes to inform the public that from information received through the Rapid Alert System for Food and Feed, said product ***must not be consumed since it contains an ingredient which is potentially contaminated with 2-chloroethanol which is a constituent of Ethylene oxide.***

Product description:	Pasta alla Curcuma e Pepe Nero Bio (Pasta with turmeric and Black pepper, Bio)
Brand:	Pasta Natura
Type of Pasta:	Fusilli
Weight:	250g
Batch:	28.01.2024

Ethylene oxide is a pesticide that is not permitted for use in foods sold in the EU but is approved for use by other countries outside the EU. Although the consumption of the contaminated product does not pose an immediate risk to health, there is an increased risk if there is continued consumption of this chemical in contaminated foods over a long period of time. Therefore, exposure to ethylene oxide needs to be minimised as much as possible. This recall is also in line with common approach agreed Member States at https://ec.europa.eu/food/system/files/2021-07/rasff_ethylene-oxide-incident_e410_crisis-coord_sum.pdf.
