- b. Semi permanent Tattooists providing training must have at least five years working experience in a licensed parlour (confirmed by a copy of the licence). Any individual claiming to have achieved this working experience in another EU country must provide concrete evidence of such claim.
- c. All individuals attending for a semi permanent tattooing course have to be at least 18 years of age.
