

L.N. 42 of 2020**PUBLIC HEALTH ACT
(CAP. 465)****Travel Ban Order, 2020**

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by article 27(c) of the Public Health Act, the Superintendent of Public Health has made the following order:

1. The title of this order is the Travel Ban Order, 2020. Citation.
2. (1) The Superintendent of Public Health hereby orders a travel ban on persons to and from any of the countries listed in sub-article (2): Travel ban to and from Malta.

Provided that the Superintendent of Public Health may, in his absolute discretion, suspend the provisions of this order, by notice in the Gazette, where, in the opinion of the said Superintendent, the travel of certain persons deemed to be essential.

- (2) The countries to which this order refers are the following:
 - (a) Italy
 - (b) Switzerland
 - (c) France
 - (d) Germany
 - (e) Spain
 - (f) China, including Hong Kong
 - (g) Singapore
 - (h) Japan
 - (i) Iran
 - (j) South Korea:

Provided that the Superintendent of Public Health may, at his discretion, increase or reduce this list by notice in the Gazette.

Offences and penalties.

3. Any person who fails to abide by the provisions of this order shall be guilty of an offence and shall, on conviction, be liable to the payment of a penalty in accordance with the provisions of article 44 of the Act for each and every occasion that the provisions of this order are breached.
