



COVID-19 Transitioning - Standards for extracurricular and adult learning activities carried out in educational and organised settings

Applicability

The obligatory conditions in these Standards are issued under the Public Health Act CAP 465 and require strict adherence. Failure to adhere to these conditions will result in enforcement procedures as provided by the Act. These standards apply for all extracurricular and adult learning activities carried out in educational and organisational settings, including, but not exclusively so, teaching outside normal school/educational bubbles, drama classes, art classes, dance classes, religious and social related classes (eg. duttrina), martial arts, etc.

Risk Assessment

Potential for COVID-19 spread is further exacerbated with opportunities for social contact outside formal/obligatory educational and work settings.

Conditions

The following obligatory conditions shall apply to all extracurricular activities as defined above:

- ✓ Only on-line/virtual schooling/teaching/training is allowed.
- ✓ Students are not allowed to attend school or the activity in person.
- ✓ All communication between the tutor/school administration and student is to be carried out on-line.
- ✓ Students are not to engage in any social activities.
- ✓ No organised activities are allowed for or by the students.
- ✓ Exceptions will be made for practical formal examination sessions which require in-person attendance which in turn can only be carried out in accordance to the strict mitigation measures laid out for such sessions.
