

Temporary Closure of the Gżira Health Centre

As from 14th May 2020 the Gżira Health Centre will be closing its doors to make way for the mega-refurbishment, which will be part-financed through the National Development Social Fund (NDSF) grant secured by the Primary HealthCare in May 2019. The refurbishment project is expected to be ready in 2021.

As from 15th May 2020 until the completion of the project, the residents of the Gżira Health Centre catchment area will be able to continue to receive a number of salient services from the Primary HealthCare's Temporary Premises in St Albert Street Gżira, which premises was made possible through the assistance of the Gżira Local Council.

The Temporary Premises will be open from Monday to Sunday with the same opening hours of the Gżira Health Centre.

The services that are going to be available from the Temporary Premises include:

- (1) General Practitioner Service
- (2) Nursing Service
- (3) Bloodletting Clinic
- (4) Point of Care Anti-Coagulant Clinic
- (5) Result Review Clinic (temporary suspended because of the COVID-19 situation)
- (6) Diabetes Clinic (temporary suspended because of the COVID-19 situation)
- (7) Treatment Room
- (8) Wound Management

All the other Services which are usually available through an appointment basis, will be available from the Floriana, B'Kara and Mosta Health Centres. The Primary HealthCare's Client Support Centre will be coordinating these appointments with the patients accordingly. The patients will be notified of their appointment through a telephone call and a SMS when their appointment will be due.
