**“Empowerment and Self-reliance for Women Refugees in Malta”
(ERF 2011-03)**

AIM:

To strengthen and expand the integration measures for residents at the transition centres in Malta, with a focus on the situation of women at Hal Far Reception Centre, *Dar il-Liedna* and those already living within the community.

PROJECT ACTIVITIES:

The project focuses on four components – (1) self-reliance; (2) training and education; (3) social interaction and ownership of the living environment; and (4) personal care.

Activities comprise:

1. Vocational training
2. Information classes on nutrition and care
3. Literacy training
4. Social events & cultural orientation classes
5. Group co-ordination & interaction lessons
6. Lessons in communicating in daily life
7. Discussions and awareness raising on gender issues
