
Dear Dental Surgeon

The Medical Council of Malta is the competent authority for the registration and regulation of Medical Practitioners and Dental Surgeons in Malta.

Please be informed that the Medical Council will only be able to assist you upon the receipt of a duly filled application form and submission of all the documentation requested in the Application Form. Please find a brief outline of the procedures:

1. A duly filled application form is to be submitted to the Medical Council Malta, either personally, or by another person delegated by you in writing, or by mail. Please ensure to submit all the documentation requested. Please note that photocopy service is not offered by the Medical Council.
2. You will be later notified when your Full/Permanent Licence to Practice and the Certificate of Registration are ready for collection, either by email or by phone. Please note that the Licence to Practice is signed by the Minister for Health and by the President of Malta, and therefore this may take up to 3 weeks to be delivered.
3. The First Registration Fee, which is only due when the documents have been issued and are ready for collection, amounts to € 51.30 (Article 170 of Act No. XIII of 2015, Budget Measures Implementation Act).
4. You may call at our offices (SLH-OPD, Level 1, St. Luke's Square, Gwardamangia, Malta) from Monday to Friday between 09:00 and 14.00 (or otherwise indicated by email). However, it is very important to set an appointment prior to coming in order to ensure our availability by sending an email at medicalcouncil@gov.mt. Documentation can either be collected personally, or by any person delegated by you in writing, upon presentation of their I.D. Card.
5. The Licence and Certificate of Registration can also be sent by post once payment is received. Payment may be effected by cheque payable to the Medical Council, by the exact amount in cash, or by standing order (Please refer to Circular 6(2)).
6. The Annual Retention fee and the Declaration for Professional Indemnity (L.N. 84 of 2014) are due by January of each year. A reminder is usually sent by March.
